Dear Parents and Carers,

School Meals September 2017

Please find enclosed a copy of the new menu for Autumn/Winter 2017-18 which will start when we return to school in September. This menu will continue until Easter 2018 and thereafter menus will change every Easter and October half-term.

The procedure for ordering and paying for meals will remain the same. **Orders and payments must be sent to the school office no later than 3.15pm each Wednesday.**

The price of a school meal will increase to £2.20 from September - £11.00 for the week and £33.00 for 3 weeks. The cost of meals has not changed in recent years however increased costs have made this small increase necessary. Cheque payments should continue to be made out to OCC Chesterton Primary School.

Universal Infant Free School Meals / Free School Meals

All children in Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 will continue to be eligible for free school meals under the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme. If your child is in Foundation Stage, Year 1 or Year 2, or if your child is entitled to Free School Meals, no payment is required, but meal choices must still be sent in to the school office no later than 3.15pm each Wednesday.

Remember! If your child is moving into Year 3 in September, you will need to pay for their school meal choices.

Important

Term 1 starts on Tuesday 5th September. Please send in your meal choices (and payment if appropriate) for at least the first week, **no later than Wednesday 12^h July.**

PLEASE NOTE: Week commencing 4th September is Week 1 on the menu!

Finally, if you have any queries about the system or your current school meal account, please contact the school office. **Please ensure all meals for this academic year are paid up to date before the end of this term.**
