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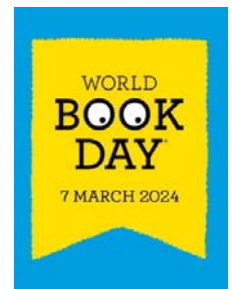

## World Book Day 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

The annual 'World Book Day' is fast approaching and we are busy planning our annual 'Book Week' in school, which will run from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March through to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Although Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March is officially World Book Day, we will be holding book-related activities throughout the entire week.



We will again be giving out £1 'World Book Day' tokens, which your child can put towards the cost of a book or they may wish to use it to buy one of the ten £1 World Book Day books.

### Dressing-Up Day

This year, we have decided to dress up for World Book Day on **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March**, so we invite your child to **dress up as a character** from one of their favourite **books**. In return for a day without uniform, we would ask that you donate £1. Any money raised will be used towards updating our class library selections across school.

During the rest of the week, there will also be lots of other great ways for us to celebrate books and reading in school, including: Drop Everything and Read; reading with a teacher from a different class; sharing favourite books, learning about different authors and joining in with book quizzes.

### Competition

In addition to our book activities, there will be a **book-themed competition** which we invite children to enter. The World Book Day focus this year is: '**Read Your Way**'. Every reader is different, and there's no right or wrong way to enjoy reading, so we are encouraging children to enter our '**Extreme Reading Competition**'. To enter the competition, all the children need to do is to read books in extreme or unusual, but safe, places. Some examples might be: on the slide at the park, on holiday, upside down, on horseback or on top of a mountain!! An entry form is attached to this letter. The children who bring in their photos of extreme reading will be entered into a competition to win a book prize.
