Date and Time

We are all very excited to be performing "Whoops-a-Daisy Angel" to you on Thursday 12th December (Start time 2:30pm). We are able to allocate four tickets per family. Siblings in school will already have had the chance to see the production during our dress rehearsal earlier in the week. Pre-school siblings are able to attend, but we kindly ask you only to bring your little ones if absolutely necessary, as we want to give our Maple Class performers the best chance to be heard during their big moments on stage.

We would appreciate it if you could find the following items for your child's costume:

Whoops-a-Daisy Angel and Angels - white top, white leggings/trousers/tights, white dress/skirt (I have halos and wings at school)

Snowflakes – white/grey/pale blue coloured top and trousers/leggings or white/grey/pale blue coloured dress/skirt and white tights (we will be adding snowflake decorations to their costumes at school)

We already have full costumes in school for the following roles: Mary / Joseph / Wise Men / Shepherds. However, please could you provide plain dark clothing to be worn underneath, for example, leggings, long sleeve top etc. This is so the children are wearing an extra layer under their costumes.

It would be really helpful if you could send these items into school as soon as possible (and definitely by Friday 6th December in time for the dress rehearsal) in a clearly named bag. All children should have black plimsolls/trainers or a similar style of shoe in school on the day of the performance. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to me.
