They will then enjoy a planetarium show all about space and the solar system. The day will end with a workshop about changing materials and their states of matter.



The coach will leave school promptly at 9:15 a.m. and arrive back to school at 2:45 p.m. This means that normal drop-off and pick-up times will apply.
