At our last Musical Instruments Sharing Assembly, we were struck not only by the quantity of children who now play an instrument, but also by their quality. Afterwards, we started to formulate a plan to give these pupils another platform to showcase their talents, particularly as many of these children are nearing the end of the time at primary school.



Therefore, we are going to host our first ever 'Musical Extravaganza' on the evening of Wednesay June 4th as part of our whole school Arts Week. The final details are still to be decided, but we will shortly be inviting a selected group of our musicians, who will be given the chance to play for an audience of parents, families and friends. We will notify children who we would like to invite to play their instrument shortly, as we want to give them time to prepare. If your child is not included this time, we really hope to repeat this event in the future, so they should have more opportunities in the future.

As part of this show, we would also like to include some vocalists, as we know that we have many keen and talented singers across the school. The school choir are performing later in June at the Festival of Voices, but this will be a chance for individuals and small groups to have their turn.

In order to decide which children will perform in June, we thought we would host a 'talent show' type event in school (May 16th), in a similar way that we did for the Poetry Performance. Therefore, if your child would like to take part, all you need to do is send in a video recording of them singing a song of their choice at home to my email address (head.3082@chesterton.oxon.sch.uk) by Wednesday 14th May (9.00am). We will then judge the entries and notify parents and children of those who have been selected to perform at the school talent show on the Friday of that week.
