




Ash Class

Summer Term 1 and 2

Creative Curriculum Focus: (Science, Geography, History and Design and Technology) This term, we will be looking at crime and punishment in History, exploring how it has changed through time since the Romans. Science will be led by Mrs Leonard, where we will be looking at scientists and inventors. We will also be doing Design and Technology, where we will be making moveable beasts using levers and sliders. After half term, we will be studying Brazil and comparing and contrasting its geographical features with the UK. In Art, we will be looking at sculptures and we will be using wire and papier mâché to create our own athletes. In this term, we will also be holding a Science week and we will be focusing on the environment.

English: This term, we are focusing our English around 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'. We will be comparing and contrasting segments of the book to the film and writing our own stories using ideas from the text. After half term, we will be researching and writing reports on the countries that are involved in this year's Football World cup. This will be followed by a short poetry unit, where we will focus on the works of one selected poet.

Mathematics: In Maths, we will be working on measuring weight accurately, reading scales and exploring money by investigating the relationship between pounds and pence. After this, we will be looking at how we can present data. In the second Summer Term, we will be recapping our knowledge of fractions and continuing to explore money through practical use.

Religious Education: We will be exploring the big question 'Does Jesus have authority for everyone?' after the half term.

PSHCE: This term we will be continuing to look at British Values, specifically at the rule of law and individual liberty.

Physical Education: This term the children will be playing cricket and rounders working on their striking and fielding skills. After half term, they will be taking part in athletics in preparation for sports day, before finishing off the year with tennis. During tennis the children will be aiming to hone their racket skills and become more accurate in their aim and serving.

Computing: This term, we will be learning how to use different Microsoft programmes where we will be focusing on how to save and retrieve documents, as well as how we can use them to present information in different ways. In the second term, we will be using the computers for Art, looking closely at the work of Picasso, Mondrian and the style of Pointillism.
