Creative Curriculum Focus: Geography

Our Creative Curriculum unit this term is 'Raging Rivers'. As part of this unit, children will study how certain river features are formed, including meanders and waterfalls. We will also be discovering what happens below the surface of the water, particularly how rocks travel on the river bed. Towards the end of the unit, children will learn how to use atlases and develop basic map skills.

Science:

Our Science unit is Evolution and Inheritance, where we will explore natural selection.

English:

This term, we will be looking at a range of poetry, including comic, narrative and rap. To connect with our Geography unit, we will be reading and writing engaging story setting descriptions based on a river. We will also be exploring explanation and discussion texts, focusing on river features.

Mathematics:

In Mathematics, we will be identifying missing angles on straight lines, points and intersecting lines. We will then explore how to read co-ordinates before translating shapes across quadrants. After this, we will be learning about algebra. We will use simple formulae to generate and describe linear number sequences.

Religious Education:

Our first unit will explore the question 'Did Jesus really perform miracles?' We will then investigate the question 'Does the community of the mosque help Muslims lead better lives?'

PSHCE:

With Miss Mansfield, children will be thinking about the qualities and skills that they have that make them unique and special in the unit 'Good to Be Me'.

Physical Education:

This term, we will continue to develop our orienteering skills in our Outdoor Adventure Activities unit. After half term, we will again be swimming at Bicester Leisure Centre.

Computing:

This term, we will be discovering how to use the app iMovie to create stop-start animations. We will have lots of opportunities to edit and improve our films.
