## **Creative Curriculum Focus: Science and Computing.**

Our Creative Curriculum unit this term is 'The Stone Age'. We will begin by looking at the way of life for people living in the Stone Age. We will explore their homes, clothing and food! We will also link our Stone Age topic to both Art and D&T. The children will be creating their Stone Age artwork, using different techniques and media. In addition, we will be designing, making and evaluating our own Stone Age homes during our D&T lessons.

Our Science topic for this term is 'Everyday Materials', where we will be investigating which material is best to build a Stone Age house and why.

### **English:**

This term we will be developing the children's writing further by exploring various punctuation marks to end a sentence. For example, a question mark and an exclamation mark. In addition, they will be looking at commas in lists along with adjectives, verbs and nouns.

We will start the term by developing our skills in report writing, using key features to write a non-chronological report about Stone Age houses. We will be exploring the difference between fact and fiction and the use of sub-headings to inform our reader.

We will also be reading the book 'A Stone Age Boy' and using this story to develop our own writing skills, with a big focus on description!

## The Stone Age!



**Mathematics:** In Mathematics, we will be investigating addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will be looking at various methods to solve addition and subtraction problems. For example; using number lines, working with practical equipment and moving on to splitting numbers into tens and ones to add/subtract 2 and 3-digit numbers. We will also be exploring different methods to solve multiplication and division problems, including using number lines for repeated addition/subtraction and using arrays to group/share.

### **Religious Education:**

Our unit this term will explore the question of 'How Should the Church Celebrate Easter?'

In addition, we will also be looking at the story of Easter and the importance of the story to a Christian.

### **PSHCE:**

Within our PSHCE sessions this term, the children will be exploring the theme 'Saying No to Bullying'.

### **Physical Education:**

During our P.E unit this term, we will be joined by Bardwell School to explore different aspects of Dance, working on sequencing basic movements.

The children will also explore ball games during their outdoor P.E. sessions with Jack.

### **Computing:**

This term, we will be learning about the importance of online safety. This will be followed by developing our understanding of using a computer correctly and safely.
