This week is South Africa week at Chesterton School. For your Home Learning, select some of the following tasks to complete:

<u>English:</u>	<u>Maths:</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete the reading comprehension about Nelson Mandela, a famous South African. Look in the bottom left hand corner of the pages - we recommend that you complete the 2 or 3 star comprehension.</li> <li>Research a famous landmark in South Africa, e.g. Table Mountain, Cape of Good Hope, Robben Island, Boulder's Beach. Write a postcard home sharing your thoughts about it.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use some holiday websites to budget a holiday to South Africa. Think about: flights, accommodation, food and attractions. How much would it cost to go away for 7 days? What is the cheapest option? What is the most expensive option?</li> <li>Make a dish that incorporates the colours of the South African flag: black, green, yellow, white, red and blue. Practise your weighing and measuring skills.</li> </ul>
<u>Topic:</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research traditional African fabrics. Design and colour in your own pattern. Could you design a whole outfit?</li> <li>Find out about the national symbols of South Africa. Create a poster of your findings.</li> <li>Paint the South African flag.</li> <li>Draw a map of South Africa. Can you find any rivers, capital cities, mountain ranges and bordering countries?</li> <li>Learn some vocabulary of one of the languages of South Africa. At Qugwala Primary School, the first language of the pupils is Xhosa.</li> </ul>
