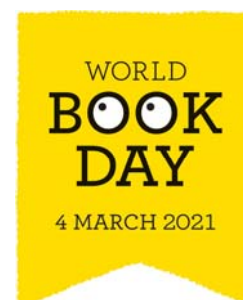

It was great fun to get creative and try to take the best Bookface photo possible.

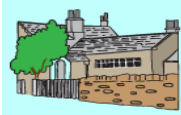
All you need to do is find a suitable book, stand behind it and start snapping! The possibilities are endless; you could get your family and even your pet involved!
