Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Wednesday 1st May**, as part of our '*Amazing Animals*' topic and previous learning on '*Fairy Tales*', we plan to take the children to Cogges Farm. The visit is designed to excite their imaginations and extend their understanding, giving the children a real-life experience. During the visit, children will have the chance to see different farm animals, collect eggs and make their own Welsh cakes.

We will be leaving school at 9am and, depending on traffic, we will return around 2:15pm. The children should wear their school uniform, as well as a coat/hat appropriate for the weather on the day. Comfortable school shoes or trainers suitable for walking should be worn.

Children can either opt for a packed lunch provided by school (**see order form below**) or can have a packed lunch and a drink (no fizzy drinks) provided by yourselves. If you choose a packed lunch provided by school, please send your child in with a rucksack and we will put their lunch in there. If you choose to provide your own packed lunch, please also put this into a rucksack. We ask for a rucksack, as children will be carrying this throughout the day and we want them to be comfortable. In an effort to be more eco-friendly, and reduce the amount of plastic bags/food wrap that often come with school trip lunches, please send your child's lunch in a normal lunchbox/bag, with their name on, inside their larger rucksack. They will bring these boxes/bags back from the trip, for you to recycle or dispose of any waste at home.

In addition, children should bring their usual school water bottle. If the weather proves to be particularly sunny, a bottle of sun cream should also be provided, so that the children can top up as necessary throughout the day.

The total cost for our lovely Maple day out is £11.00. Please give consent and make payment online in the usual way, via Scopay.

Costs will be recovered by the school for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. If you think that your child is eligible, please check with the school office.
