Vision screening for children aged 4 to 5 years

We are inviting your child to participate in vision screening, which will be conducted at their school during school hours. We will coordinate with the school to schedule a date, and they will inform you of the exact time of our visit. This service is offered by Oxford Health Foundation Trust.

As we cannot use the results to offer a second opinion/treatment or further advice.
