## **Oak Class Topic Visit to The Ashmolean Museum, Oxford**

An exciting Oak Class visit has been planned to the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, to round off our 'Egyptians' topic. The visit has been scheduled for Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2025.

At the museum, the children will have the chance to explore the Egyptian exhibition, which holds one of the most extensive collections of Egyptian artefacts in Britain. Then, the children will take part in a guided tour called 'Egyptian Detectives'. Both of these experiences will enhance the work that the children have been doing so far on our topic.



After a successful train journey to Junior Citizens, we will be travelling to Oxford again via train from Bicester Village station. Pupils should arrive at school as usual, before travelling via coach to Bicester Village station at approximately 9.45am. We will return to Bicester by train at the end of our visit. **Therefore, we please ask that you arrange transport for your child to be collected from Bicester Village train station at 3pm.**

Pupils should bring a packed lunch, drink, snack and waterproof coat and sun hat. In an effort to be more eco-friendly, and reduce the amount of plastic bags/food wrap that often come with school trip lunches, please send your child's lunch in a normal lunchbox/bag, with their name on. They will bring these boxes/bags back from the trip, for you to recycle or dispose of any waste at home.



The cost is £15 per child, including transport, which we hope is great value for such an exciting full-day visit. **Payment and consent for this trip will need to be given online via Scopay by Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July.** This payment is a voluntary contribution and no child or family will be discriminated against for not contributing. Costs will be covered by the school for those in receipt of Income Support or Job Seekers Allowance, in which case parents should contact the office with the necessary up-to-date documentation. **However, should**

**insufficient voluntary contributions be made, we will have to unfortunately cancel the visit.**
