
Curriculum

P.E.

During Spring Term 1 and 2, P.E. will take place on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. However, it is essential that children have kit in school every day. As the weather is much colder now, please make sure that children have suitable clothing for both indoor and outdoor P.E. (jumper, sports trousers and trainers).

Contact with the class teachers

If you wish to make contact with us, there are a number of ways that you can do this

- You could send a message (written or verbal) with your child.

Reminders

- Water bottles – Please make sure children have a water bottle with them every day. Please note, the children should only have water in these bottles (not squash, juice or flavoured water).
- Outdoor shoes – All children should be prepared for outdoor play by keeping wellies and a warm, waterproof coat in school.
- Please can you be mindful on the size of the rucksack/bag you provide your child with as space is incredibly limited in the cloakroom.
- **Labelled clothing** - Please can we request that all items of clothing are clearly named.
