Science:

We will be looking at light and electricity, building on skills that we have learnt previously.

English: In Term 5, we will be recapping our understanding of SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar) in preparation for our upcoming SATS. We will also be exploring the text 'The Story of Tutankhamun', where we will look at the importance of archaeologists and then write a biography on Howard Carter, the man who discovered the Pharaoh's tomb. We will also look at the book 'The Secrets of a Sun King' in Term 6, before finishing the year writing letters to the new Maple Class!

Walk Like An Egyptian!



History: We will be looking at life in Ancient Egypt focusing on Gods and Goddesses, social hierarchy, hieroglyphics, the afterlife and more!

RE: We will be exploring the questions: How far is belief in the resurrection important to Christians today? Do we need a deity to be committed to creating a better world?

Computing and DT:

Programming will be the main focus in both computing and DT. We will be exploring programming pioneers which will link to the concept of variables in programming through games in Scratch.

Physical Education:

In P.E. this term, we will be preparing for our May Day dances and honing our striking and fielding skills.

We will then be practising for Sports Day, focusing on athletics, as well as visiting the leisure centre for swimming.

PSHE: Our unit this term is 'rights and responsibilities', which focuses on how to keep ourselves safe. Please see the newsletter for more information.

Mathematics:

Maths this term will continue our work on ratio before focusing on statistics. We will then re-cap key knowledge in preparation for the KS2 SATs. After half-term, we will be looking at algebra, measurement and targeting strands which will prepare the children for secondary school!
