For your Spelling and Phonics Home Learning this week, please focus on the following spelling pattern:

-le at the end of words

This week we are going to start learning about some tricky spelling patterns that you find at the end of words.

First we are looking at words ending with an 'l' sound. Most often, this sound at the end of a word is made with the letters 'le'.

As well as having a go at learning to spell the words below, please complete some of the activities suggested to help you learn about 'le' endings.

Words ending with -le	
apple	bubble
battle	table
able	candle
juggle	bottle
ankle	sparkle
