

## Prepositions

In the story, 'The Queen's Hat' the hat flew:

**Through** London Zoo

**Along** the London Underground

**Around** the London Eye

**Across** Tower Bridge

**Over** Big Ben

**Down** to Kensington palace

(Remember a preposition tells you where or when something is in relation to something else) Write at least 5 different prepositional sentences. You can be as creative as you like as to where the hat flew to! The hat may even fly out of London if you wish!

Try to include a conjunction in every sentence too- this will ensure your sentences are detailed enough.

The Queen's Hat flew **under** the number 45 bright red, double decker bus which was taking Ash Class on a sight-seeing tour around London.
