For your Spelling and Phonics Home Learning this week, please focus on the following spelling pattern:

### Words ending in -y

This week, we will begin to think about using a 'y' at the end of words and what sound it makes.

Sometime the 'y' at the end of a word makes an 'ee' sound. Sometimes it make an 'igh' sound.

Please help your child to practise spelling the following words which contain our focus spelling patterns.

Words with a 'y' that makes an 'ee' sound	Words with a 'y' that makes an 'igh' sound
baby	fly
copy	cry
very	dry
party	reply
family	July
