The outdoors is so much fun when there's snow around!


Here are Benjamin and Matthew having a great time on their sledge!

book this week. He used his phonics to sound out the words and drew some great pictures too!




Noah has been feeling musical this week. Here he is with a few different instruments that he is learning to play. Can you name them all?
